

## Student Info Sheet on Online Learning

Dear Students,

Online education is a different platform that we all have to learn using together. Obviously, the way of teaching and learning will differ from what we have been used to. There are some principles that we would like to share with you.

- 1. You are more responsible for your learning than ever. This means that your work will have a more direct impact on your own learning.
- 2. You must do the readings for RW and Core classes before the online sessions. If you don't, you won't be able to benefit from the online lesson or your teacher's feedback in the session.
- 3. You must study the vocabulary before the online sessions for all courses Core, RW, and LS.
- 4. When the teacher goes over the vocabulary items in class, check if you understood them correctly when you were studying on your own.
- 5. Try to use the new words in your essays, summaries, and sentences as much as possible.
- 6. You are going to have vocabulary quizzes each week in RW and LS classes.
- 7. You are going to have **production tasks** each week in Core classes.
- 8. **Do not plagiarize** in any of your homework assignments. Your teachers will grade your essays. If they find out or believe that your essay is in fact NOT your work, you will get "0".
