There are two courses in the Prep Summer School Programme. You can see the details below (Summer School Courses).

Weekly Schedule

- 2020 Summer School courses start on June 24, Wednesday.
- You have 20 hours of classes every week: 10 hours of Core & Writing and 10 hours of Exit Exam Practice.
- You don't have classes on Friday.
- The courses are online, so your teachers will design the one-to-one instruction and individual task assignment according to your needs and the progress of the courses.
- **Only for week 1, the courses start on Wednesday with Tuesday schedule.**
